

Local Elders Who Need Help

You, your family, friends, and neighbors may directly benefit from the interest generated from this fund. The Gap Fund is already helping local elders like Ms. T...

Ms. T suffered a stroke that left her quite disabled. When she returned to her home after a four-month stay in a rehabilitation facility, she was confined to a wheelchair and found it extremely difficult to adjust. Errands and chores that she once did on her own before her stroke now took extreme effort or were impossible all together. Ms. T's annual income was just a few dollars over the state eligibility guidelines for subsidized home care services, but she couldn't afford to pay for help on her own. With support from the Gap Fund, she now gets assistance with grocery shopping and house keeping services every other week.

Ms. T is receiving the help she needs to stay safely in her own home.
